

Portland Youth Dance Scholarship For Casco Bay Movers Dance Class

Description: As part of our mission, Portland Youth Dance is dedicated to providing financial assistance to young dancers interested in developing their dance and performance skills. **A limited number of awards may be granted based on a student's interest in and dedication to dance, accomplishments, aptitude, as well as financial need. The following financial award is available to apply for:**

- <u>Dance Class Scholarship</u> For dancers ages 6-18 years that are interested in regular, weekly dance classes and performance opportunities. The full or partial amount granted based on financial need for either the full year (August deadline) or half year, (December deadline) of tuition fees for a dance class at Casco Bay Movers Dance Studio throughout the 2024/2025 season; scholarships will also include a costume and performance ticket.
- The Portland Youth Dance Board of Directors accepts applications on a rolling basis.

Application deadlines: July 15, 2024 for classes from September 2024 to June 2025

Eligibility Criteria - To qualify, an applicant must be between the ages of 6 and 18, meet financial eligibility criteria outlined below, and submit a completed application before the designated deadline.

Financial Eligibility - Applicants must meet financial eligibility requirements. To determine eligibility **proof of total household income must be provided and includes:**

- Wages for ALL adult wage earners in the home(s): Last year's tax return, W2's, OR 2 current pay stubs
- SSI or other benefits
- Child support payments (even if a parent does not choose to collect this support) or divorced/separated parent's income (in lieu of child support documents).
- Trust funds
- All other sources of income

All applicants who meet the income guidelines as defined below by Portland Youth Dance will be eligible for consideration for a Scholarship. It is PYD's policy that all information will be used solely to determine eligibility, held strictly confidential, and not shared with any outside parties.

Annual Income Eligibility Chart

Full vs. Partial Awards - If the applicant meets the 100% fee assistance requirement and is selected, a full scholarship will be awarded. If the applicant is not within income guidelines for 100% fee assistance but can prove a financial need as defined above, partial financial assistance may be provided as indicated on the chart above. In this case, a board member will meet with the Parent/Guardian to review this option.

Application Process—Applications for assistance must be completed in their entirety and submitted by the deadline. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Decision Process—The Portland Youth Dance Board of Directors will review completed applications for approval or denial. The Board will notify applicants once a decision has been made.

Completed applications must contain:

- PYD Dancer Application Form
- Parent/Guardian Application Form
- A written letter of recommendation from a teacher, dance instructor, or another adult non-family member
- Proof of household(s) income (Last year's tax return or two current pay stubs)

^{**}Incomplete or late applications will not be eligible for consideration**
